

DISCUSSION	
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- School District appeal: A new Conciliation hearing is scheduled for May 23rd to counter the potential of the School District performing a property appraisal, we had our guy do one. As expected, this raised our "fair market value" value from \$1,155,000 to \$1,200,000 and applies for years 2023 and 2024. When combined with the lower common level ratio it could lower our assessed value from \$733,400 to \$655,200. (lower tax rates by ~12%). We'll see what they present at the meeting.
- <u>Current Revenue Scorecard</u>: missing some information.
 - o Approximate 77K from member dues & activities, 49K from L2C's and Group Events, 64K from bonspiels. Total revenue just over \$216K

Proposed New Member incentives

Definition of new member

- Any first timer to the club
- Anyone that curled at RMU and hasn't returned (out of curling for at least 3 years)
- Anyone new that joined for first time during the Spring 2024 session

Incentives:

- Credit LTC fee and include Base membership for any combined fall/winter or unlimited membership commitment (\$150 discount)
- If purchasing only single session (fall, winter, spring) Credit for LTC fee only (\$50 discount)
- If a new member did LTC1, LTC2 & LTC3 series, additionally get 2 LTC gift certificates for friends/family (Lora is still working on this.)

New member Discount Implementation

- Discount codes set up in JoinUs
- Discount codes given to New Members, can be applied at checkout during registration process
- Draft version of 2024-2025 Registration and Discount codes currently set up in JoinUs to "Preview" mode. Pending approval/any changes can be activated for online registration.
- Draw masters for 2024-2025 Draws and schedule
 - Confirmed interest in continuing next year
 - Communicated plans to split draws depending on demand
 - Recommend Draw masters have a backup, suggest spare policy and need for guidelines to help draw masters manage their draws. Drawmasters will take it from here and be their own group.
