Discussion

- Several members, and a few people at bonspiels have expressed that they would like it if we had less prominent (or totally non-existent) "TV" lines in the ice.
 - Reasons given: people getting too hung up on the idea of a "fall" on or off of the line, difficulty teaching new
 curlers to aim at the broom instead of the line, and a few of the better Canadian teams at bonspiels saying
 the lines are distracting.
 - Suggestions from members included making the lines skinnier, using a different material such as twine or rope, or eliminating the lines altogether.

Conclusions

The ice committee will take this under advisement for 2025-2026 curling season and will consider using yarn.
